- 2017-2018 was another successful season for Nepean.
- We fielded a total of 20 minor teams, 2 Open teams and 2 sessions of Bunnies (JR & SR)
- Many of our competitive teams experienced success; with our U16 AA
 winning Gold during Provincials. This team (U16AA) carried on to Nationals
 in Winnipeg where they represented Nepean as Team Ontario. They had a
 strong finish and won the Bronze medal.
- Our U19A team and U16A team had strong 4th place finishes in the Jacks Division, while our U14A won silver in the Lajuenesse Division all at provincials in Kitchener.
- Our U12 Provincial Daigle finished their season with a Silver medal in the Lajuenesse Division and were also awarded the Sportsmanship award. U12 Graham won Gold in the McCarthy Division.
- The recreational teams once again enjoyed participating in the NCRRL Championship weekend. Our Nepean teams did well with, U16B winning Silver, U14C winning Silver, U12 Churchill Silver and U9 team taking home Gold.
- Nepean Ringette continues to shape its efforts of its Executive around 3 key initiatives: Increasing Membership, Increase Goalies, Development of Coaching Development

We have 4 certified Come Try Ringette leads on our Executive Team.

Coaching Development

We continue to run a variety of initiatives to better train and support our coaches – both adult coaches and youth coaches in training.

Nepean has a long history of having very qualified coaches and we're trying to leverage them to mentor and pass knowledge onto other coaches in training. We're also trying to increase the number of female bench staff members.

We continue to have Paul Youldon as a paid "Head Coach" to officially train and mentor coaches.

Paul created many resources for coaches and worked 1-1 with several of our Head Coaches. He videotaped games for teams and walked bench staff through the video replay to illustrate things he advised them to work on.

Organized a Youth Coach in training course again this season. 20 players U14 and U16 age, preparing them to become on ice helpers and Coaches in Training (CIT)

More and better goalies - (Joe Tremblay)

Lead instructor Jasmine Leblanc NRL & Team Canada Goalie

Ran 10 dual sessions for U9-U14A and U14AA to U19-AA goalies

Sessions ran from September to December to avoid busy Post Christmas Tournament schedules

Each Ravens team should have a goalie coach and they are encouraged to attend

Had numerous on ice volunteer shooters and U16AA Goalie instructors

We have Keely Brown's Drill book that we can lend Goalie coaches

Paul Youldon ran a Goalie Coach session that had tremendous attendance

Participants were show basic goalie drills, tactics, stance etc.
