E. Presentation and Approval of Reports President's Report (Wendy Seguin)

2018-2019 was another successful season for Nepean

- We fielded a total of 20 minor teams, 3 Open teams and 2 sessions of Bunnies (JR & SR) on two different days
- Many of our competitive teams experienced success; with our U19 AA winning Bronze during Provincials. This team (U19AA) carried on to Nationals in PEI where they had a strong finish and finished 4th in Canada
- Our U19A team had strong 4th place finishes in the Jacks Division, while our U12 Provincial Blue Steckly won Gold in the Lajeunesse Division and were also awarded the Sportsmanship award and our U12 Provincial Red team – Graham won Bronze in the Cockburn Division at provincials in Guelph
- Our regional teams once again enjoyed participating in the NCRRL Championship weekend. Our Nepean teams did well with, U16B Archambault winning Gold, U16B White with Silver, U12 Pleau with Gold, U10 Coates with Silver and U9 Stynes with Silver as well

Nepean Ringette continues to shape its efforts of its Executive around 3 key initiatives

- 1. Increasing the Membership
- 2. Coaching Development
- 3. More and better goalies

Increasing the Membership

- We have 4 certified Come Try Ringette leads on our Executive Team.
- Participated in the regional "Come Try Ringette" events (September, May & July) and a "Bring a Friend to Bunnies" event (September and March) AND "Bring a Friend to Practice" at Novice!!
- Hosted a Nepean Ringette Booth during Canada Day celebrations in Barrhaven.
- Participated in Mary Honeywell Elementary School's Health and Fitness Expo to bring the excitement and fun of playing ringette to a school with only a few players....but those numbers are growing!
- Getting out in our Community is key!

Coaching Development

- We continue to run a variety of initiatives to better train and support our coaches both adult coaches and youth coaches in training.
- Nepean has a long history of having very qualified coaches and we're trying to leverage them to mentor and pass knowledge onto other coaches in training. We're also trying to increase the number of female bench staff members.

- We continued to have a highly qualified technical Head Coach, to train and mentor coaches.
 We have developed resources for various levels, including specific to goalies to support our volunteers.
- Organized a Youth Coach in training course again this season. 20 players U14 and U16 age, preparing them to become on ice helpers and Coaches in Training (CIT)
- We also held two "Coach get-togethers" which were informal and allowed coaches to share best practices and solve common issues together. On the technical side, we recruited a very strong skating coach and the feedback on this program has been extremely positive from players, parents and coaches.
- New Leadership this year for our Goalie Clinics. Seasoned Goalie Coaches Joe Tremblay and Derek Seguin, ran the program with the help of Dave Stathos goalie instructor Alex Lawrence

Ran 10 dual sessions for U9-U14A and U14AA to U19-AA goalies

- Sessions ran from September to December to avoid busy Post Christmas Tournament schedules
- Each Ravens team should have a goalie coach and they are encouraged to attend
- Had U14A, U14AA & U16AA Goalie instructor volunteers on with the novice goalies
- We have Keely Brown's Drill book that we can lend Goalie coaches
- Paul Youldon ran a Goalie Coaching session that had tremendous attendance
- Participants were shown basic goalie drills, tactics, stance etc.
- We have new Goalie Development options for the 2019-20 session. Due to popular demand, we will be increasing the number of sessions from 10 up to at least 15. We will be sending youth goalie instructors to team practices and have those female instructors in the change rooms at the clinics to help encourage young goalies and answer any and all questions about this great position.
- Introduced EdgePower An exciting new power skating program for everyone from Novice to U19 both regional and competitive. It was well attended with some fantastic results. It will be back next season.
- We are currently working on a Skills Clinic program to help players sharpen their skills like Shooting, Receiving the ring and crisp passing. Sarah-Lynne Begin will lead this great initiative.
- We continue to run a sold out summer ringette program for kids in U10 all the way up to U19. There will be new coaching leads this summer with the addition of goalie instructors as well.
